League Winter Competition 2018-19

Proposed rules

- 1. Open to any individual member of a Monmouthshire (Gwent) based shooting club, and to teams of 3 (a club can enter more than one team) but must be entered by a club official who confirms the participants' current average (see below).
- 2. Two cards per calendar month running from November 2018 to March 2019.
- 3. Separate cards for individuals and teams, but individuals can opt to have their card count for both competitions as long as this is declared beforehand and both the team and individual sticker appears on the card scored.
- 4. Clubs will score their own cards but these should be retained so that the organizers may audit any rounds at random.
- 5. Cards must be dated and witnessed, and the scores sent to the organizers by email or post by Saturday of the first full week after the end of the month being shot.
- 6. Clubs may nominate an experienced scorer to score their own cards using an appropriate .22 gauge to ensure consistency. However, all cards should be kept to the end of the competition in order that a random audit of rounds may be carried out.
- 7. Cash prizes and a certificate/prize to the first, second and third places in the individual and team competitions. The first place in the team event and individuals in each Division will receive £50, 2nd place £25 and 3rd place £15.
- 8. Results will be based purely on the aggregated scores i.e. highest total scores count.
- 9. Clubs should nominate who will be shooting in each of their teams at the start of the competition.
- 10. There will be a £3 fee for each individual entry, with no additional fee for teams.
- 11. Divisions will be formed based on numbers of participants and their current averages at the start of the season. This will be based on their last 10 cards if they have no competition history on which to base their proficiency. Averages should be given to one place of decimal e.g. participant X has an average of 93.6.
- 12. All clubs and individuals will participate at their own risk. The organizers can take no responsibility for the safety of those participating in this competition given the variety of times and places when cards will be shot, and all individuals and clubs are urged to ensure they follow safety rules to the fullest and ideally should carry their own insurance.
- 13. All entries by the end of September. If insufficient entries the competition ill not take place.
